English

Children continues with her phonics and reading skills in guided reading sessions. In literacy lessons Children listens to stories and completes a wide range of comprehension task. She also participates in fine motor skills and handwriting programs. Children is learning to become a more independent writer. She is learning appropriate spelling and grammar skills and the use of a dictionary.

Speech and Language Therapist and PSHE

Our Speech and Language Therapist team supporting the children every Monday and Wednesday afternoon. The children participate in turn taking Art sessions where they further develop their communication skills by listening and giving instructions to each other. They participate in Attention Autism sessions to extend their attention span skills. In PSHE lessons the children have started with a new social skills program. They also continue to participate in social skills and anger management games.

The children are consistently encouraged to be kind friends using our anti – bullying board, follow the class' rules, ignore bad choices and to use the 5 – point scale to manage their emotions.

Music

All children in Ash class attend a music session every Friday 2.10 – 2.40 pm with our specialist music teacher, Mr Paul Gregory. The sessions are very calming and therapeutic for the children and involve exploring a range of instrument, following the rhythm of different music styles and turn taking skills in a small
